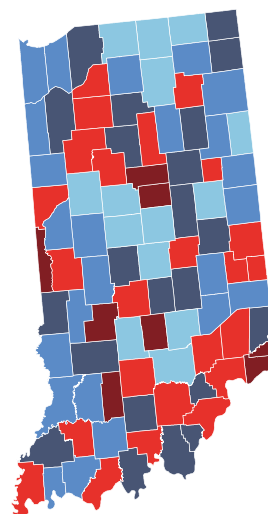

In 2014, 11,304 VA home loan guarantees were made in Indiana to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 7.2 percent of Indiana's home mortgage originations in 2014.
