

Approximately 57,321 Tennessee veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 21.4 percent of Tennessee veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS 12,218



In 2023, 12,218 VA home loan guarantees were made in Tennessee to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 10.4 percent of Tennessee's home mortgage originations in 2023.
